- Call to Order ➤ Chairman Evans called the meeting to order at 8:17 a.m.
- II. Approval of Board meeting minutes Mr. Burnham motioned to approve minutes from the March 9, 2012 Board meeting. Seconded by Mr. Betts; motion carried unanimously.

III. Old business:

- > IATSA Conference appears to have been successful
 - Well received
 - Good feedback
 - Occurred over spring break, consider April for next conference
- > Balla v. Idaho Department of Correction
 - Mediated
 - Consent decree and special master monitoring over 2 years
 - ♦ Secure Mental Health Facility discussion
 - DJC is looking at Mental Health issues
 - Developmentally Disabled population
 - Developmentally Disabled sex offenders
- IV. Juvenile Psychosexual Evaluator discussion
 - ➢ Ms. Garay:
 - There is a need in the outlying regions for evaluations
 - A provider has been approached about doing evaluations and wants to avoid a conflict of interest; evaluations & treatment

- If there is no other treatment provider, the court can issue an order
- Avoid an inappropriate pattern of behavior
- Transitional only
- V. Guidelines review
 - Evaluation standards
 - Ms. Baird needs to get draft evaluation standards out to providers
 - Review Notice and Consent for Psychosexual Evaluation form
 - No significant comments: Approve sending out for comment with request for written feedback and provision for an open hearing in the future
 - Synopsis proposal
 - Best practice is to let the court know risk level is a comparison with other sex offenders – not general population
 - Risk level is not a reflection of potential harm
 - Low risk is not about dangerousness
 - Synopsis should be a summary, not a regurgitation of the report, but the highlights of what the evaluator wants the court to consider
 - Evaluator standards
 - Ms. Baird requested feedback regarding splitting out denial appeal process, reciprocity and responding to complaints to make its own section
 - Appropriate and approved
 - Group all Senior Level qualifications
 - Group all Associate Level qualifications
 - ◆ Statute no longer indicates evaluator must have Idaho Licensure
 - Differentiate Licensure vs degree
 - This is directly related to those doing cross-border evaluations
 - 30 day temporary license limit through IBOL
 - Already must be licensed to do treatment in the state where the service is provided
 - Reciprocity with Washington
 - Will remove Idaho requirement
 - SOMB will approve treatment for Idaho offenders conducted in other states by SOMB certified providers
