I. Call to Order

- Vice Chair Johnston called the full-board meeting to order at 8:35 a.m.

II. Approval of Board Meeting Minutes

Ms. Simmons motioned to approve the minutes from the June 10, 2016 board meeting. It was seconded by Mr. Crawford and all members present voted aye.

III. Board Business

- Board members discussed funding assistance for the upcoming IATSA conference and the importance of quality training for partners responsible for sex offender management.

Ms. Simmons motioned to provide funding assistance for the IATSA conference in the amount of \$10,000. It was seconded by Mr. Betts and all members present voted aye.

- A preliminary review of the SOMB's funding allocation was presented by Ms. Baird. Further discussion on budgetary issues will take place at a future meeting.

- A request was received to develop a list of PhD psychologists who would be willing to provide testing interpretation services for masters level psychosexual evaluators. Ms. Baird will approach the Idaho Psychological Association about this.

- VI. Subcommittee Reports
- Dr. Johnston provided an update on the Adult Registration Subcommittee.
 - ◆ Work has been suspended pending STATIC-99 coding rule modifications and work on consistency in psychosexual evaluations.
 - Mr. Betts provided a recap on direction for the Juvenile Registration Subcommittee.
 - ◆ Pending planning to develop a 2-level system; a mechanism is needed for movement between levels; and work on consistency in psychosexual evaluations. A process for review of inadequate psychosexual evaluations needs to be developed.

- SOMB Senior Level Adult Psychosexual Evaluator Certification
Mr. Betts motioned to approve the advancement to Senior Level Adult Psychosexual Evaluator certification application with monitoring from Robert Lisota, PhD. It was seconded by Mr. Sonnenberg and all members present voted aye.
- SOMB Senior Level Adult Psychosexual Evaluator Certification
Mr. Crawford motioned to approve the Senior Level Adult Psychosexual Evaluator certification renewal application from Dalton Lombard, LCPC. It was seconded by Mr. Betts and all members present voted aye.

- Review of proposed updates to the Post-Conviction Sex Offender Polygraph Examiner standards.

- ◆ All SOMB-certified Post-Conviction Sexual Offender Polygraph Examiners were sent the proposed standards update in advance and invited to this meeting for input/discussion. None attended and no comments were received.
- ◆ Alternative language to the provision for grandfathering of currently certified examiners into Senior level status was discussed and approved by the board. Ms. Baird will notify examiners about the modified standards update.
