- I. Call to Order
 - Chairman Evans called the meeting to order at 08:10 a.m.
 - II. Approval of Board meeting minutes

Mr. Burnham motioned to approve minutes from the August 10, 2012 Board meeting. Seconded by Ms. Simmons; motion carried unanimously.
 - III. Old Business
 - Responses have been received related to the qualifications for using some testing materials
 - ◆ Want clarification and guidance
 - ◆ Looked at Pearson, PAR, Inc., and MHS
 - ◆ Consider appending qualifications to the Standards document
 - ◆ Evaluators must comply with the ethics of their licensing agency
 - ◆ Phone calls will be made to those that have expressed their concerns
 - Draft statutory language
 - ◆ Lewd and Lascivious Conduct
 - This language was developed by the ICJC VSP Subcommittee approximately 2 years ago and breaks this code out to be better for sentencing
 - ◆ Sexual Abuse
 - Was also drafted approximately 2 years ago for the same purpose
 - ◆ Both fit into the registration guidelines that are currently being developed by the SOMB Tiered Registration Subcommittee
 - ◆ These drafts will be submitted to the ICJC as part of the overall package for Tiered Registration
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Director Reinke stopped by to wish the SOMB a happy one-year anniversary.

- Year in Review
 - ◆ Making good progress on Guidelines
 - Expect Polygraph and Supervision pieces to go quickly now
 - Will invite polygraphers to help write that portion as no one here is an expert
 - ◆ Goal is to wrap up adult language by the end of the calendar year in order to move into hearings by January
 - ◆ Juvenile language should be drafted and ready to go by the end of the school year
 - ◆ Start rules promulgation process by summer 2013
 - ◆ Make presentations to the germane committees, legislators prosecutors, public defender's group, sheriff's association and to the public
 - ◆ Have already submitted the Notice for Evaluator, Evaluations and that will be posted in October. Public comment will close for negotiated rulemaking in November
 - ◆ Temporary rule will be published in January or February and can then be implemented
 - ◆ Rules will become final in 2014

- Evaluator approvals will expire in December 2012
- Those will be extended until the rules are final and to allow enough time for the evaluators to implement the new standards and submit documents to that standard for new certifications
