Hello,

The information below is meant as a Sexual Offender Management Board (SOMB) approved statement to be included in all psychosexual evaluations that fall under the jurisdiction of the Idaho SOMB.

Recently the SOMB became aware of the concern regarding the MSI-II testing results being delayed due to an absence of a clinical psychologist as a result of a medical emergency. Based on this information, the SOMB held a special meeting last week and voted to temporarily suspend the requirement for evaluators to administer and include MSI-II results in their psychosexual evaluations. This will be effective from April 15, 2024 until we are notified that the company has hired a clinical psychologist and is once again able to interpret results. At that time, we will send out a follow up email notifying all evaluators that the temporary suspension has been lifted and you will once again be required to administer and include the results of the MSI-II in your evaluations.
